**The Good Grief Center**, Pittsburgh's first and only comprehensive center for bereavement support, will move to its new 3,200 square-foot home in Squirrel Hill at the Shops at the Morrowfield located at 2717 Murray Ave. GGC will open its doors there on June 2.

The new facility, which is more than double the size of the organization's original location in Homestead, will enable GGC to meet a growing demand for its services. This move makes it possible for GGC to successfully continue to implement a comprehensive growth plan. Elements of this plan include expanding core services and extending community reach. GGC, which has served over 15,000 people since it opened in 2001, is a comprehensive bereavement resource and referral center that builds a more compassionate community through grief awareness, education, support and hope; creating a safe place where all who have experienced the pain of death may come to work through loss and learn to manage grief.
